01 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

All Care Nepal is an animal welfare organisation based in Butwal, Nepal. Founded in 2020 by Deepak Rijal (Founder/President) and Akash Dhimal (Founder/Executive Director), the organisation rescues, treats, and cares for street dogs across the city, while working hand-in-hand with local government to keep both animals and people safe.

Rabies is preventable, but only if enough dogs in a community are protected. A single missed booster can leave a gap in that protection. That is why All Care Nepal runs regular, on-the-ground vaccination drives — going street by street, home by home, so that no dog and no neighbourhood is left out.

WHAT THIS CAMPAIGN DID

Between **2083-03-24** and **2083-03-26**, All Care Nepal's field team delivered rabies booster doses to **97 dogs** across **25 locations** in Butwal Sub-Metropolitan City, working over three consecutive days to reach street dogs, home-kept dogs, and puppies alike.

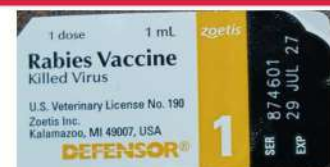

Beyond the numbers, this campaign reflects something simple: a promise that every dog on Butwal's streets matters, and that keeping them healthy keeps the whole community healthier too.

02 CAMPAIGN OVERVIEW & TEAM

This drive was carried out in close partnership with Butwal Sub-Metropolitan City, combining All Care Nepal's field experience with local knowledge of where dogs are most in need of care. The route was planned to move steadily across the city — starting in Kalikanagar and Devinagar on Day 1, continuing through Hattisud and the eastern neighbourhoods on Day 2, and finishing with a wide, street-by-street sweep of central Butwal on Day 3.

FIELD TEAM

Lead Vaccinator: Tech. Sahil Tharu — responsible for hands-on vaccination, health screening, and on-site treatment of every dog.

Technical Oversight: All Care Nepal Program Management — responsible for route planning, record-keeping, and coordination with municipal authorities.

Every dog was approached the same way: calmly, carefully, and with someone from the neighbourhood nearby whenever possible. This matters just as much as the vaccine itself — a stressed or frightened dog is harder to treat safely, so the team took time with each animal rather than rushing the count.

03 OPERATIONAL DATA — DAY 1

2083-03-24 — the campaign began in Kalikanagar, moved through Devinagar, Hatti Path, and Majgau, then closed the day in Pavitra Nagar and Hattisud.

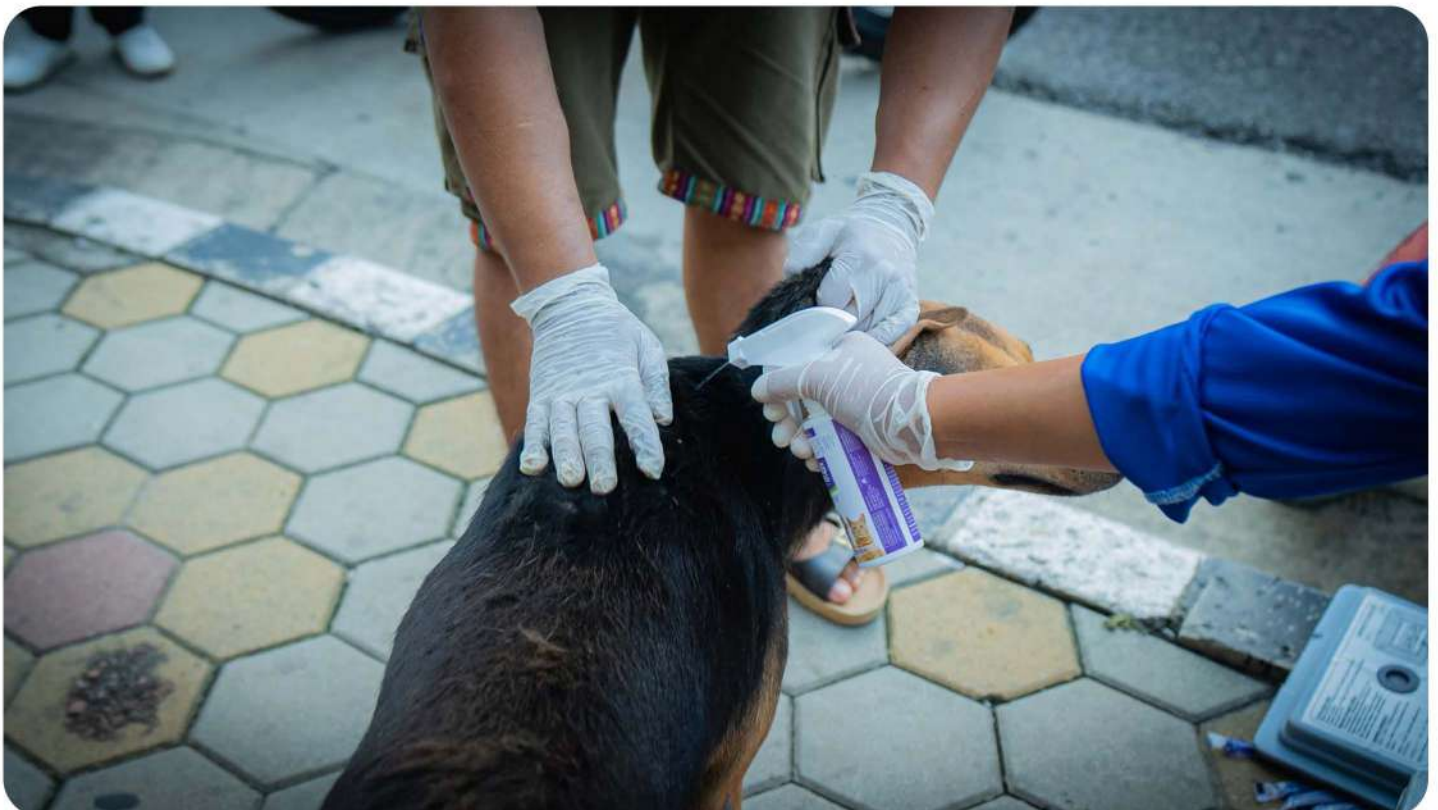

04 SPECIAL CARE & HEALTH FINDINGS

Vaccination was not the only thing the team did in the field. Whenever a dog needed extra help, the team stopped to treat it on the spot or made a note for follow-up. Here are the cases worth highlighting:



Day 1 · S.N. 5 Recovering from Distemper

A young home-kept dog in Devinagar was found still recovering from a past distemper infection and was checked before vaccination.

Day 1 · S.N. 10 Eye Problem

A dog in Devinagar was noted with a problem in its left eye and has been flagged for further check-up.

Day 1 · S.N. 13 Oncology Follow-up

A dog undergoing post-cancer chemotherapy was checked and monitored at Hatti Path alongside its booster dose.

Day 1 · S.N. 22 & 23 Skin Care — Majgau

Two dogs with active skin conditions and allergies received Ivermectin treatment.

Day 2 · S.N. 4 Injury — Leg Fracture

A dog at Hattisud was found with a leg fracture and has been flagged for rehabilitation follow-up.

Day 2 · S.N. 7 Skin Care — Sauti Chauki

A dog with a skin allergy was treated with Ivermectin during the visit.

Day 2 · S.N. 14 Post-Treatment Monitoring

A dog at Sauti Chauki, already under earlier treatment, was checked again during this visit.

Day 2 · S.N. 16 Skin Care — Sunuvalo Nagar

A dog showing signs of skin irritation was treated with Ivermectin.

Day 3 · S.N. 5 Skin Problem — Opp. Dream Intl.

A dog near Dream International was found with a skin problem and was noted for care.

Day 3 · S.N. 7 Maggot Wound Treatment

A young puppy at Gantantra Path was found with a maggot-infected wound and was treated on-site by the field team.

Day 3 · S.N. 20 Skin Problem — Butwal-6

A dog in Butwal-6 was found with a skin problem and was noted for follow-up care.

05 DOCUMENTATION & PHOTO VERIFICATION

To keep this record honest and easy to check, the field team photographed almost every dog at the moment of vaccination.

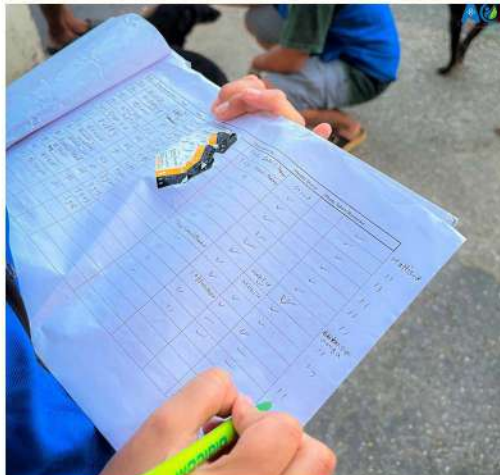
94 of 97 Dogs Photographed

Photographic evidence was captured for 94 of the 97 dogs vaccinated during this campaign. The final three dogs on Day 3, recorded at Bhuvan Singh Marga (S.N. 37, 38, and 39), were not photographed due to field conditions. 06 CLOSING

Three days, 25 locations, 97 dogs — but really, this campaign was about something much simpler: showing up for the animals that share our streets, and for the people who live alongside them. Every booster dose given this week means one fewer risk to a family, a child, or a neighbour. That is what rabies prevention looks like in practice.

All Care Nepal thanks Butwal Sub-Metropolitan City for its continued partnership, and remains committed to returning, street by street, until every dog in Butwal is protected. This is what it means to build havens for animals — not just shelter, but a whole city that looks out for them.

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
